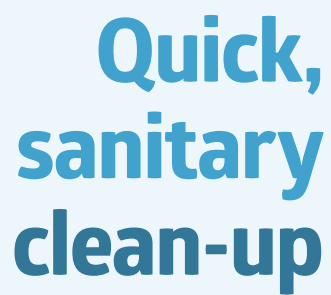

# Emesis Bag

Medline's disposable Emesis Bag provides a safe and easy solution for the collection, containment and disposal of vomitus. That is in addition to quicker and more sanitary clean-up for healthcare workers.

Our easy-to-handle plastic bag can be easily closed with a plastic comfort ring, isolating contaminants, pathogens and unpleasant odours. This also contributes to less cross-contamination of floors and other surfaces, as well as fewer linen changes and floor cleanings.

Emesis bags help improve patient experience by offering:

### Improved patient experience

- Less splashback and mess than with basins
- More privacy and discreetness for patient dignity
- Enhanced independence and self-help

### Enhanced sanitation

- Contained and covered vomitus
- Isolated contaminants and pathogens
- Less cross-contamination of floors and other surfaces

### Quicker clean-up

- Easier to clean up patients after sickness
- Fewer linen changes and less mopping of floors
- Option of disposal in regular or red bag trash

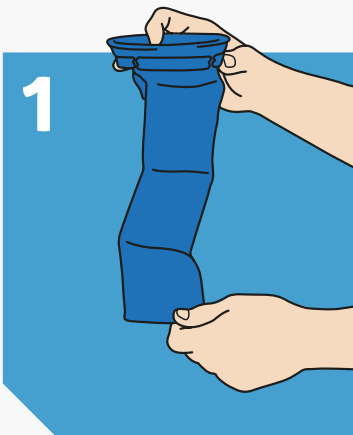
### Some reasons for emesis

- Chemotherapy and other cancer treatment methods
- Post-operative sickness
- Pregnancy
- Infections, sickness or diseases
- Motion sickness

### Reasons paper or metal emesis basins fall short

- Higher amount of vomitus splashback
- No discretion for patient dignity
- Not a very clean and sanitary method
- More cross-contamination of surfaces can occur
- Not easy to clean up and dispose of

## How it works:



Hold the comfort ring and pull the plastic bag down gently and away from the ring, thereby, unfolding the bag.



Cover your mouth with the comfort ring, directing the vomitus into the bag.



Secure the contents by gripping the bag and twisting the ring.

Tuck the tightly twisted bag into one of the four notches around the ring to close it, and then dispose of the bag.\*

\*Please refer to the hospital's policy for waste disposal.

### Emesis Bag

It is particularly indicated for patients whose vomitus is caused by drug therapy/radiotherapy. The darker colour helps improve patient experience by offering discreetness and privacy.

### Clear Emesis Bag

It is ideal for use in emergency/pre-hospital care or whenever the examination of vomitus is needed.

### Emesis Bag Dispenser

This dispenser mounts easily and conveniently on the wall, and securely holds up to 24 of our folded emesis bags. The top lid covers the contained emesis bags, thereby, aiding in infection control.
