



What is Occupational Contact Dermatitis?

Do you have it?

Contact dermatitis is a red, itchy rash caused by an allergic reaction to your skin after being exposed to a foreign substance. The most common causes include jewelry, gloves, perfumes, chemicals and soaps.¹



Irritant contact dermatitis is the most common type. This occurs when foreign substances damage the surface area of the skin. The irritants can penetrate the outer layer causing inflammation.²



Allergic contact dermatitis occurs when a substance to which you're sensitive (allergen) triggers an immune reaction in your skin. It usually affects only the area that came into contact with the allergen.²

IF YOUR SYMPTOMS ARE:

- Skin redness
- Burning skin
- Extreme itching
- Oozing blisters

Allergic Contact Dermatitis

Allergic reactions can be triggered by exposure to the synthetic chemical accelerators in the glove material.³

Chemical accelerators are added to the formulation during the manufacturing process.

According to one study, 80% of glove-associated allergic contact dermatitis is by chemical accelerators in gloves.⁵

In a study of patients with allergic contact dermatitis due to accelerators in rubber gloves, dermatitis cleared in a subset of patients for whom accelerator free gloves were provided.⁸

Irritant Contact Dermatitis
